Municipal Conservation Zone Apu Pachatusán

The Municipal Conservation Zone Apu Pachatusán (3650 masl.) is located at the south of the city of Cusco, in San Jerónimo and Oropesa districts and it houses fauna and flora species. This zone is currently affected by forest fires, negatively impacting on the ecological and agricultural conditions of such area, as well as on the habitat of the species, local families and the area itself. The objective is to promote the ecological restoration and local & municipal environmental sector of Apu Pachatusán by means of reforestation.



This project is carried out by Machu Picchu Institute, which promotes the conservation of natural and cultural resources of Machu Picchu Sanctuary and the region of Cusco, by supporting projects related to sustainable tourism, agro ecology, handicraft, small industries and scientific research.
